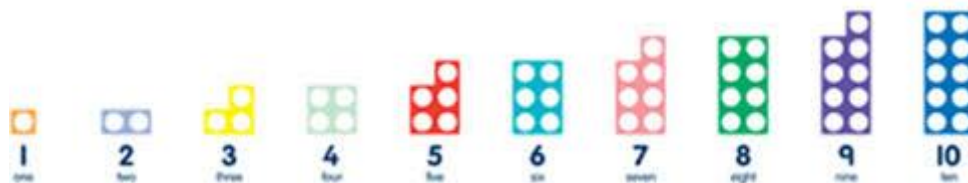


Primary 1/2 - Learning Leaflet

Term 2

Numeracy



Primary 1 - This term we will revise numbers to 10 including recognition and formation of numerals, numbers that come before, after and in between and reading the number names. The concept of addition will be introduced. We will continue to count amounts accurately, pointing to each object as we count.

Primary 2 - This term some of the children will begin work on addition and subtraction to 20 and others will continue to work hard on numbers to 20 concentrating on ordering, larger/smaller, counting in 2s and 3s and identifying the number names. Beat That! challenges will be given as homework tasks to continue to improve mental maths abilities.

All - A new learning and teaching resource to the school, Numicon, will be used regularly with the children to support the maths topic they are focusing on.

Literacy



Primary 1 - g, l, f, o, b, u, h, w, v, y and z are the sounds to be introduced this term. We will regularly practise making and writing simple 3 letter words using the known letters. Correct pencil grip will continue to be emphasised. More words will be added to word boxes to help with Oxford Reading Tree texts as well as books from supplementary reading schemes.

Primary 2 - ue, aw, oi, au and ew will be the taught sounds this term as well as lots of consolidation and revision of previous taught sounds. They will continue to receive spelling words each week to learn at home and will have focused reading tasks both at home and in the classroom. Independent writing will always be encouraged, specifically throughout focused writing lessons.

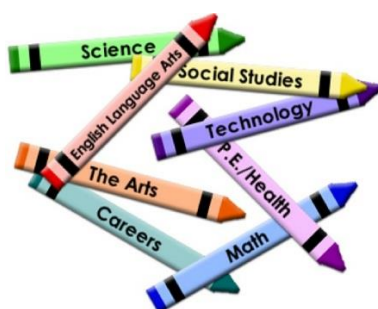
Health and Wellbeing

P.E. continues twice a week - on Tuesday mornings with the class teacher and Friday mornings with the P.E. specialist. Our class P.E. focus this term will be yoga.

Learning Across the Curriculum



Our topic for term 2 will be Toys and will focus on the science behind different types of toys, toys from the past compared with now, how toys are made and even making our very own toys. As part of our Toys topic we will learn about puppets, reading the story Pinocchio, as well as using the ipads to create our own puppet shows using the app Puppet Pals. All children will also present a talk on their favourite toy, guidelines and a date for their talk will be issued.

Science continues twice a week with Mr Cole-Hamilton and French will be also be introduced to this term.

Masterclass time for the Primary 1 children will be set aside for the year group to work on "The Nativity" which will be performed in December. Primary 2 will continue to attend selected Masterclasses alongside the rest of the primary 2 year group.
