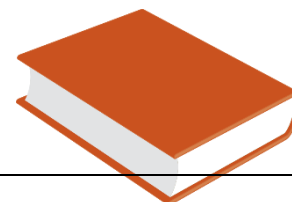
Term 1

Numeracy



<u>P2</u>	<u>P3</u>
<p>After a brief revision of addition and subtraction to 10 and the formation and recognition of numerals to 20, our focus will be on numbers to 100.</p> <p>We will consolidate our knowledge of our BIG MATHS Beat That facts to try to improve the speed and fluency.</p> <p>Some topic related information handling will be completed.</p>	<p>Our focus will be on Place Value to 100. Alongside this, we will be adding and subtracting tens and units vertically (chimney sums) and setting out work carefully. Times tables (2 and 5) will also be introduced.</p> <p>We will consolidate our knowledge of our BIG MATHS Beat That facts to try to improve the speed and fluency.</p> <p>Some topic related information handling will be completed.</p>

Literacy

<p>We will begin by revising some digraphs then move onto the sounds ph, ay, ea and ow. We will continue to revise the spelling of common words.</p> <p>Formation of letters and correct pencil grip will be covered. In story writing, the correct use of capital letters and full stops is expected.</p> <p>Children will be allocated new working groups in reading and various texts will be studied.</p>	<p>We will begin by revising P2 phonemes and common words then move onto the sounds tch, wr and ea.</p> <p>In story writing, we will continue to develop Big Writing skills. Correct spacing between words will be encouraged in handwriting. Alphabetical order, nouns, verbs and adjectives will be introduced.</p> <p>Children will be allocated new working groups in reading and various texts will be studied.</p>
