To Parents/Guardians,

Happy New Year! Term three has got off to a positive start here in P7K and we hope that it continues. The following leaflet contains information regarding what the children will be learning in term three.

Literacy



The Active Literacy approach will continue in spelling and in reading.

Active spelling is continuing to operate on a four week cycle, weeks one and two concentrate on a spelling rule, week three focuses on technical vocabulary and week four is a revision week of the spelling rule. This is practised in class and reiterated through homework tasks.

This term we will be finishing our class novel 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. The children are enjoying the novel and are looking forward to finding out how it ends. We will also begin reading groups in week three and details of reading homework will be noted in their diaries. We will continue to explore different reading strategies and techniques working both independently and with others.

This term we will be focusing on poetry, imaginative and functional writing. We will continue to use planners to structure our ideas into the correct format and to up-level the range of VCOP we are using.



Numeracy

In Term Three, we will be learning about money, data analysis (topic linked), fractions, decimals and percentages. Please continue to work on the quick recall of number bonds and times tables facts as we focus on improving our Beat That' tests (from the 'Big Maths' programme).



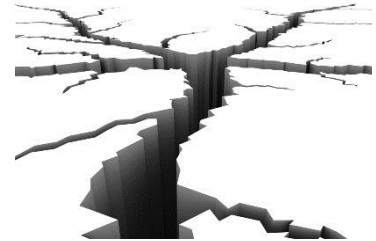
Health and Wellbeing



In term three, the main focus in Health and Wellbeing will be staying safe. We will specifically look at a range of different scenarios that could potentially affect one's safety; for example internet safety. There will continue to be a focus on promoting positive relationships. This term in PE we will be focusing on gymnastics, netball, yoga and football.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Natural Disasters will be our topic this term. We will explore a range of natural disasters, learning about causes and factors, and make meaningful links and comparisons to Scotland/and the UK.
