
Term 3

## Numeracy

We will continue to explore the concept of adding amounts up to 10. We will work on 'missing' number sums e.g.  $5 + \_ = 7$ . P1W will also focus on numbers to 20.

The children will investigate information handling, 2D / 3D shape, symmetry and money.

We will begin using Big Maths strategies for mental maths.



## Literacy

We are learning the sounds qu and x and will then work on reinforcement of recognition and correct formation of all the letters of the alphabet. We will also be learning sounds sh, ch, th, wh and ng.

We shall use the sounds in simple words. P1W will begin to look at some common words including I, the, went, to, into and do.

We shall also continue to develop the children's reading and vocabulary through the Oxford Reading Tree reading scheme.

Later in the term we will introduce spelling words for the children to practise at home. Skills for class talks on Our Home will be discussed. More information will be sent home about this task. Encouragement and support will be given to sound out words and write with more independence.



Class Library will be on a Thursday.

## Health and Wellbeing

The children may get the opportunity to visit the ALEC caravan. They will also investigate which foods they need to be healthy and explore the different food groups.

This term P1W will reflect on their learning and achievements in Term 2 and set new personal learning targets.

In P.E. we shall develop small equipment skills and be introduced to gymnastics with Mrs Hunt.

This term gym will be on a Monday and Wednesday.



## Learning Across the Curriculum

Our learning context for Term 3 will be Houses and Homes.

In French, this term your child will continue to revisit basic greetings, saying their name, numbers to 10 and recognise simple classroom language. They will also be introduced to basic weather statements. The children will be reflecting on a selection of Bible stories and will explore Chinese New Year.

There will be an opportunity to bake later in the term.
