Numeracy



<u>P2</u>	<u>P3</u>
<p>In Numeracy, we will be working on addition and subtraction to 20, encouraging quick mental recall.</p> <p>We will use I-pads to support our learning where appropriate.</p> <p>We will consolidate telling the time using o'clock and half past and then calculate durations.</p> <p>We will explore ways of gathering, recording and interpreting data.</p>	<p>In Numeracy, we will continue with addition and subtraction using tens and units. We will revise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and learn the 3 and 4. We will also focus on improving the speed of recall of number bonds to 20.</p> <p>We will use I-pads to support our learning where appropriate.</p> <p>We will explore ways of gathering, recording and interpreting data.</p> <p>We will work on recognising and using combinations of coins to £10.</p>

Literacy

<p>We will focus on the correct use of capitals and full stops in sentences and encourage the use of adjectives.</p> <p>Functional writing, using notes to create a written piece of work will be introduced.</p> <p>The Active Literacy approach to spelling will continue.</p> <p>Dictionary work will be introduced.</p> <p>Written responses to what has been read will be extended.</p> <p>Information about class talks will follow.</p> <p>Handwriting will focus on the correct formation and size of both small and capital letters and neat presentation.</p>	<p>There will be an emphasis on the correct use of capital letters, full stops and joining words. Varying the words to start sentences will be encouraged. Dictionary work will be consolidated.</p> <p>We will be focussing on functional writing, using notes to create a written piece of work.</p> <p>The Active Literacy approach to spelling will continue.</p> <p>Information about class talks will follow.</p> <p>Answering comprehension questions in sentences will be worked on.</p> <p>Handwriting will focus on joining letters correctly and neat presentation.</p>

Health and Wellbeing

The Good To Be Green approach to promoting positive behaviour has now been established throughout the school. It will continue to give recognition to those who behave appropriately.

We will be looking at how to keep healthy and how to react in unsafe situations. We will also discuss Internet Safety linked to Internet Safer Day on the 6th February.

In P.E. we will begin to develop gymnastic skills, try to improve our fitness and improve ball skills.

This term gym will be on a Monday and Wednesday.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Our learning context this term is Ancient Egypt. We will be looking at how the Ancient Egyptians lived, making comparisons between then and now. The children have already shared what they know and have created a list of what they would like to find out. There will be many opportunities for drama, music and art activities related to the topic.
