Activities for pre-school children moving to Primary one are underway. All new P1s are invited to take home an "Aim to be Awesome" pack weekly. ## Bikeability

Following numerous attempts to resolve issues in the playground, staff are still dealing with a high number of incidents relating to football. I hope that this decision will be supported and that a fresh start on Monday will be welcomed by all.
