P4+ P4/5 lines/bad weather procedures

As many of you will know our playground can be a very busy place in the mornings. Can we kindly ask all parents/carers to leave appropriate space outside our P4 and P4/5 classrooms to allow the children to line up accordingly. In the event of bad weather, pupils in P4 and P4/5 should enter the main building via the P3/P5 door and line up in the hall where they can wait until the bell rings. Class teachers will pick them up from the hall and escort them over to their classes.
