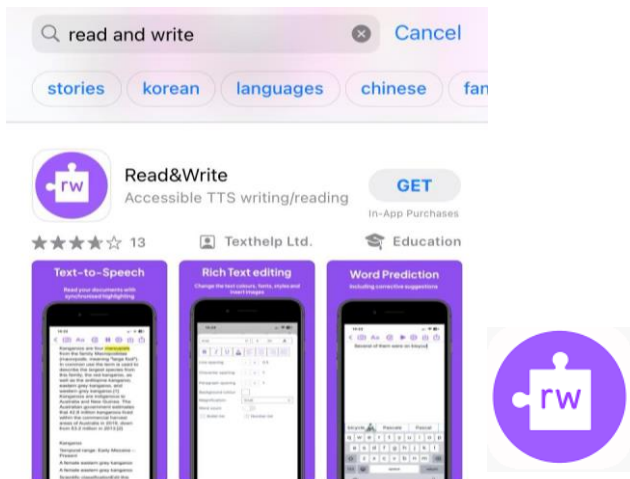
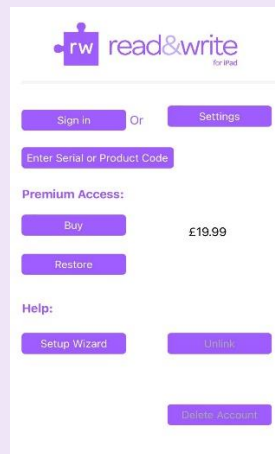
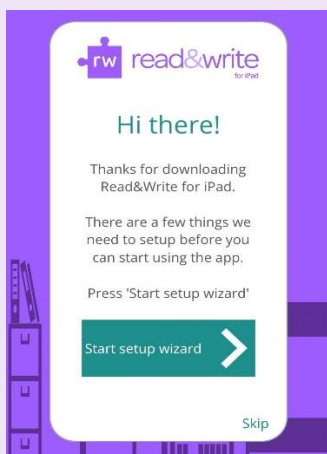


Installing Read and Write Software onto Ipad/Iphone at Home



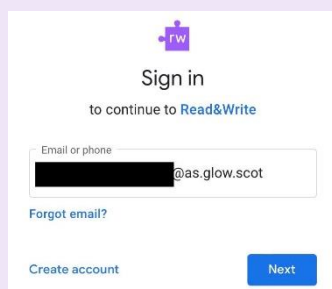
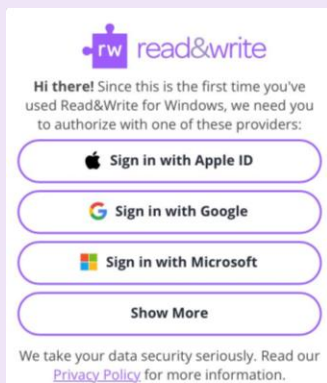
Download App from the App Store

- Search for Read and Write in the App store
- Click “get” to download it and input your iCloud password to approve download.
- Once downloaded, the app will appear on your home screen.



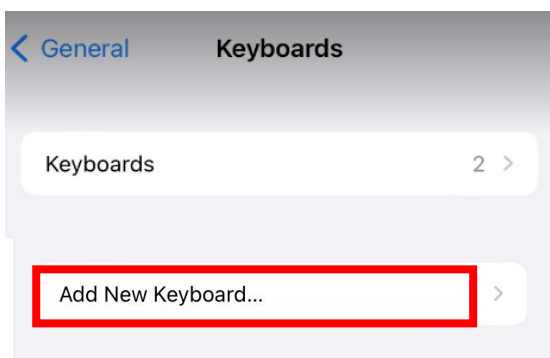
Logging into App

- Launch the app from your home screen
- Click “Start the Set Up Wizard”
- Click “already have an account”
- Click “sign in with Google”
- Use your child’s glow username followed by @as.glow.scot (gw19potterharry@as.glow.scot) and their normal Glow password.



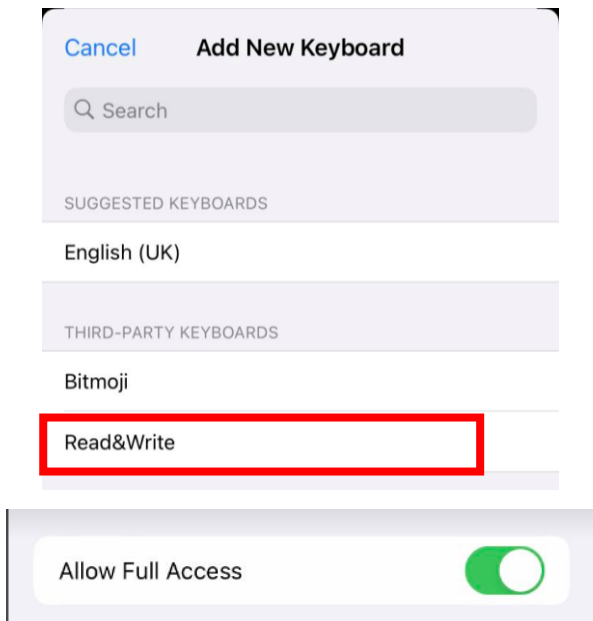
DO NOT use the normal @glow.sch.uk username as it won't be recognised.

You should not be paying for any service. Please contact school if it is asking you to pay.



Adding to Iphone/Ipad Keyboard

- Go to settings on your Iphone or Ipad
- Click “General” → “Keyboard”
- Click “Keyboards” → “Add New Keyboard”

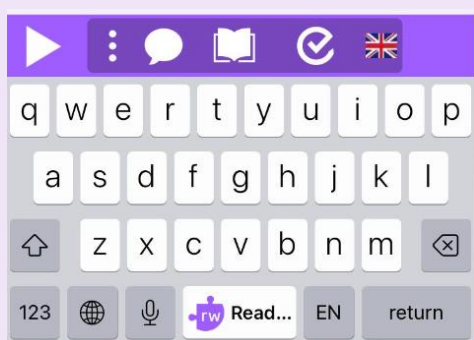


- Read and Write Should be under 3rd party keyboards. Click on the 3rd party keyboards.
- Slide to enable full access.



Using Read and Write Keyboard

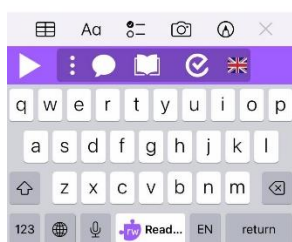
- Open any app that allows for typing (notes, messages, emails etc)
- Click the Globe icon at the bottom left of the keyboard and tap until the read and write keyboard (purple) is displayed.
- Ensure that you have the Union Jack selected so that spelling predictions use the British and not American spellings.
- The icons at the top of the Read and Write keyboard (purple strip) match those used on the online Read and Write Toolbar.



Using Keyboard

Either type or dictate your sentences using the Read and Write keyboard.

- The speech bubble will turn on prediction.
- The play button will read your sentence back to you.
- The open book will give you a dictionary.



Personalising the Read and Write Keyboard

- Open the Read and Write app from your home screen.
- At the top right hand side of the screen, click the “settings” icon (looks like a gear/cog) and click “settings”

The following alterations are possible:

- change the voice to a different accent in “Voice Name”
- change the speed of reading by sliding the slider
 - snail = slower
 - hare = faster
- change the keyboard theme colour to pink, teal, orange or green
- change the font to be a dyslexia friendly font in the “Keyboard Settings”
- highlight vowels to an opposite colour to consonants in “Keyboard settings” → “highlight vowels”
